NEW RESIDENTIAL CARE RATES BENEFIT LOW-INCOME SENIORS

About a quarter of seniors in residential care in B.C. will now receive up to an additional \$600 a year.

The change is the result of the Province increasing the minimum monthly disposal income amount for residential care clients to accommodate a federal government supplement top-up of \$50. Under a revised residential care rate structure, the monthly minimum disposable income amount will rise to \$325, up from \$275.

Raising the minimum amount will allow low-income seniors to keep the new federal Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) increase, which was announced by the federal government in July 2011. The GIS is a federal program which provides additional money to low-income seniors, on top of the Old Age Security pension: <http://www.servicecanada.gc.ca/eng/isp/pub/oas/oas.shtml>.

Currently, residential care clients pay up to 80 per cent of their after-tax income toward their room and board costs, provided they are left with at least \$275 a month to cover personal expenses. The GIS increase led the Province to raise the amount retained by low-income seniors to \$325 a month so they will not lose the extra income provided by the top-up.

New residential care rates, which take effect Feb. 1, 2012, will range from \$932 a month to a maximum of \$3,022. Private pay rates are usually in the \$4,000 to \$5,000 a month range.

To set the client rates, the Province uses income tax data from the Canada Revenue Agency. The rate-setting process usually begins in August, and is completed in the fall. Rates are then provided to health authorities, who mail notification letters to clients, informing them of the new rates.

The provincial government subsidizes the room and board costs of over 90 per cent of all residential care clients. No one who needs residential care services will be turned away as hardship provisions are available for those who are unable to pay. Every client will also continue to have 100 per cent of the cost of health-care services provided in residential care facilities covered by the Province.

Quote: Minister of Health Michael de Jong - "In the spirit of co-operation, we have been working with the federal government to support seniors in residential care. We wanted to ensure those low-income seniors who qualify for the federal income supplement top-up did not lose this extra income. That's why we are increasing the provincial monthly disposable income amount to assist those who need it most."

Quick Facts: * About 7,000 clients are eligible for the provincial \$50 increase.

* Residential care provides 24-hour nursing care, as well as room, board and recreational programs to more than 26,000 British Columbians with complex care needs.

* The cost of operating a residential-care bed is estimated to be \$6,000 a month.

* Residents receive coverage for most prescription medication, medical supplies and equipment.

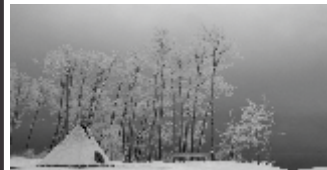

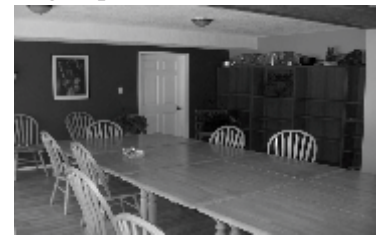

THE FACTS ABOUT RADON GAS

Radon is a naturally occurring gas that seeps out of the soil beneath your house and can enter your home through cracks in the foundation, around window frames, through sumps or other openings and is heavier than air so it can build up in the lower levels of your home.

Radon is a breakdown product of uranium which exists in soils all over the world. Due to its radioactive quality, radon's decay into alpha particles can cause damage to lung tissue that can, with long term exposure, lead to cancer. The Canadian guideline is 200 Bq/m³ (Becquerels per cubic metre) and your risk increases with an increase in exposure.

This carcinogen is present in about 30 per cent of homes in Prince George and about 20 per cent across the north. It is odorless and colourless, so there is no way to tell if it is there except to test for it. Homeowners need only test once unless they are conducting renovations in the basement or ground floor.

Radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer, second only to tobacco smoke. It is estimated to cause between 1,500 to 2,000 deaths from lung cancer per year in Canada. Radon exposure in smokers increases the already high risk of developing lung cancer.

Many people are concerned about the effect that a radon test might have on their house value. The US Environmental Protection Agency's Home Buyer's and Seller's Guide (<http://www.epa.gov/radon/pubs/hmbyguid.html>) suggests that there has been no effect in the US. The decision to test your home is the first step in protecting your family from radon.

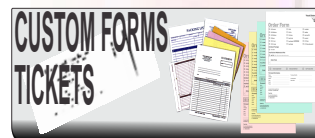

The Very Best Eggnog, Ever

- 1 quart milk
 - 2 cinnamon sticks
 - 1 vanilla bean, split
 - 5 cloves
 - 10 blades of mace
 - 12 egg yolks
 - 1&1/2 cups sugar
 - 1&1/2 cups dark rum
 - 1&1/2 cups brandy
 - 1 tablespoon vanilla
 - 1 quart of "half-and-half"
or 1 quart of light cream
or 1 cup of heavy cream plus
 - 3 more cups of milk
- freshly grated nutmeg to taste

*Combine milk and spices including vanilla bean in a heavy saucepan and let them infuse over lowest possible heat for 5 minutes. Meanwhile, combine yolks and sugar in a large bowl and whisk until mixed.

*Bring milk to a boil and gradually whisk it into the yolk mixture. Return the mixture to the saucepan. Cook over medium heat, stirring steadily with a wooden spoon, for 2 to 3 minutes, or until foam subsides and mixture thickens to consistency of heavy cream. (Mixture should thickly coat the back of a wooden spoon.) Do not boil, or mixture will curdle.

*Strain mixture into a large bowl and let cool to room temperature. Stir in rum, brandy, half-and-half, vanilla and nutmeg.

*Refrigerate eggnog for at least 2 hours, preferably overnight. Just before serving, dust top of eggnog with additional nutmeg.
