The players were also taken for a tour of the home team's dressing room where the Bantams were able to meet with Rage Players and get autographs.

SOARING MINERAL EXPLORATION MARKS INDUSTRY'S REVIVAL

The dramatic revival of mining in British Columbia was underlined today with the release of exploration spending figures for 2010 that were more than double the amount for 2009.

Speaking at Mineral Roundup 2011, Minister of State for Mining Randy Hawes revealed \$322-million was spent on mineral exploration last year. This represents the third-highest total in the province's history and a 109 per cent increase on the \$154-million spent in 2009. By way of comparison, in 1999 mining exploration expenditures were only \$25 million.

"This is a remarkable turnaround for the mining industry, which shows continued steady growth from the lows of the 1990s," said Hawes, who also proclaimed this week Mineral Exploration Week in British Columbia. "Policies put in place by this government have helped give the minerals sector the resilience to withstand the economic downturn that we've experienced recently, providing thousands of high-paying jobs in all corners of the province."

In addition to exploration spending, the mining industry invested more than \$1 billion last year expanding existing operations and developing new mines in B.C. Exploration and mine development investments are both key indicators of mining's future.

"This year's figures are representative of the increased drilling and sampling that is required to find and build tomorrow's mines for the benefit of all British Columbians," said Gavin Dirom, president and chief executive of the Association for Mineral Exploration British Columbia.

"Perhaps the greatest indicator of mining's excellent health is the development of new mines," said Hawes. "These figures suggest a very bright future for mining, and the provincial government will continue to provide an attractive investment climate to attract new mine development."

Along with the construction and mine development underway at Copper Mountain, New Afton and Mt. Milligan mines in 2010, there were also major mine expansions at Endako, Gibraltar, Highland Valley Copper and Wolverine mines.

A Word With Your Creator
69. END OF THE WICKED Part 1 of 2

We are alive today. Is mankind destined to live forever? Has God promised eternal life to the wicked as well as to the righteous? Did God make a mistake when He said, "The wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 6:23. In the Bible man's life is pictured as being like a shadow or vapor that soon passes. Man is mortal (Job 4:17); he is corruptible (1 Corinthians 15:53, 54). Since he must seek for immortality if he desires eternal life, it is clear that man does not have a natural immortality within him. (Romans 2:7).

1. Through whom and by what means are eternal life and immortality made possible?

"But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel." 2 Timothy 1:10.

2. What is the source of eternal life?

Immortality belongs alone to God (1 Timothy 1:17; 6:16). "We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death. Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him." 1 John 3:14, 15. Read also 1 John 5:11:-13.

3. Will those who reject the gospel have eternal life?

Peter asks this question, "What shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?" 1 Peter 4:17, last part. David gives a clear answer when he says, "The LORD preserveth all them that love him; but all the wicked will he destroy." Psalm 145:20. Read Proverbs 13:9.

4. Is it possible that when the Lord uses the word destroy to represent future punishment, He means that the sinner shall live eternally in torment?

Take a look at how God uses the words destroy, destroyed and destruction. He said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man, and beast, and creeping thing, and the fowls of ...the air..." Genesis 6:7, first part. He said further: "behold... I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein is the breath of life, from under heaven; and everything that is in the earth shall die." Genesis 6:17. But then He told Noah, "And of every living thing of all flesh, two of every sort shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep them alive with thee; they shall be male and female." Genesis 6:19. It is clear that the threatened destruction would put an end to their lives. Only those in the ark would continue to be living beings.

5. What was the result of the Flood?

"And all flesh died that moved upon the earth, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of beast, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth, and every man: all in whose nostrils was the breath of life, of all that was in the dry land, died. And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven, and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained alive, and they that were with him in the ark." Genesis 7:21-23.

When the Lord uses the word destroy to express the punishment of the wicked He means just what the word literally means. The Hebrew word for destroy is machah in Genesis 6:7 and means to wipe off, to wipe away, to blot out or to destroy.
