JOB OPTIONS BC BUILDS BRIDGES TO EMPLOYMENT

Out of work and need a hand getting back into the job market? A new \$15-million employment and skills training program can help unemployed British Columbians gain the skills, confidence and experience needed to find employment.

"There are unemployed British Columbians who are determined to do anything they can to find gainful employment, and this program will give them a helping hand in getting back into the job market," said Ida Chong, Minister of Regional Economic and Skills Development. "B.C.'s economic success depends on having a well-educated, highly skilled workforce, and Job Options BC is one more step in building the foundations for that success."

The Province is providing \$15 million each fiscal year for Job Options BC - a program that consists of four to six weeks of facilitated group work followed by an additional four to six weeks of work experience, preparing participants for new employment, or when appropriate, further training. When needed, individuals completing the program can also access up to six months of additional support to help them succeed.

"Through the Canada-B.C. Labour Market Agreement, we are helping to build a skilled, trained and capable workforce," said the Honourable Diane Finley, Minister of Human Resources and Skills Development. "Programs such as Job Options BC are vital to ensuring all Canadians have the essential skills they need to get good jobs and build better futures."

Job Options BC builds on two successful and proven programs, the Targeted Initiative for Older Workers program and the Return to Work Employment Program pilot. Eligible participants for Job Options BC are unemployed, and not currently Employment Insurance (EI) clients.

Under the Canada/BC Labour Market Agreement (LMA), the Government of Canada is providing the Province with approximately \$66 million annually until 2013-14. Through a variety of programs and services, this funding increases access to training for unemployed individuals who are not currently EI clients, including those who are underrepresented in the labour market. Funding also supports programs/services for employed individuals who are low-skilled, or who require recognized credentials to reach their full potential in the current marketplace.

MAYOR'S REPORT

January 28, 2011

A large portion of the District budget is what we spend on capital projects. Although we have not concluded budget deliberations, we do have some degree of certainty on the amount we wish to spend, and on which projects. (Capital projects are generally considered as building or purchasing something new, or adding to something we already have, versus the costs of operating or maintaining an existing facility or program.)

This year our two biggest expenditures are likely to be the construction of a new access from Highway 97 to the Recreation Centre and the demolition of the Chetwynd Motor Inn. The new access is required to help alleviate the congestion we currently experience in getting onto the street and highway. The demolition of the Motor Inn is a result of the dangerous state of the building and the reluctance of the owners to address the problems.

The costs for these projects are still being determined, but are estimated to be \$780,000 for the access road and \$350 - \$400,000 for the demolition. A provincial grant and cost sharing with the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure has been requested for the access road. We will tender the contract for the Motor Inn to determine the cost, which will be paid by the District, unless the owners comply with our bylaw and do it themselves. (Note: the District's costs would be billed as a charge against the property and then may be collected through the tax collection process.)

Other projects being considered are a new roof for the Pine Valley Exhibition Park (\$130 - \$260,000, depending if done in one year or split over two years), new lighting for the skateboard park (\$35,000), new card readers for water stations (\$60,000), upgrades to the junction of South Access Road and 51st Street (\$100,000), paving 53rd Avenue between Highway 97 and 42nd Street (\$111,000), upgraded wireless communications systems (\$50,000), new sidewalks (\$80,000) and the completion of a number of plans for subsequent years' projects. New equipment purchases include a new tandem axle dump truck (\$130,000) and a used bucket truck (\$75,000).

As new and updated information is obtained over the next couple of months we will refine our numbers and finalize the budget. Hopefully, if we obtain partner funding for the access, and the hotel is demolished without our intervention, we will be able to reallocate dollars to other projects. We currently have many more projects than we can fund within our budget in any one year. Some of these projects include the realignment of South Access Road at 50th Street, joining Nicholson Road to Highway 29 North, new storm drains on North Access Road, widening and paving Westgate Road and a storm sewer system / road upgrades for the Rodeo Subdivision.

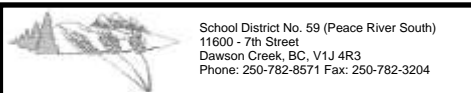

A Word With Your Creator

68. WHERE IS HELL? Part 2 of 2

1. Are the wicked being punished in hell fire now?

No. There is coming a day when this will take place. "The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished." 2 Peter 2:9. It is reasonable that men should be judged before punishment.

2. What determines when people will be judged?

"Because he hath appointed a day, in which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead." Acts 17:31.

The world was not judged before Christ rose from the dead and it has not been judged yet. The final day of executive judgment is yet future, it will take place at the close of the millennium, 1,000 years after the second advent of Christ. Read Revelation 20:11-15; 2 Peter 3:7.

3. What part of man will be cast into hell fire?

"And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched; where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched. And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched. And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire: where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched." Mark 9:43-48. The whole body, that is, the entire person, will be cast into hell. Read Matthew 5:30.

4. How long will the wicked burn?

The lake of fire into which the wicked are cast is the same fire that burns and purifies the earth. This settles the question about the fire burning for eternity, for God will create the earth anew for the redeemed. Read 2 Peter 3:13; Matthew 5:5; Malachi 4:1; 2 Thess. 1:8, 9.

5. Since hell fire cannot be quenched does this mean the fire will always burn?

No. Anciently God said He would kindle a fire in Jerusalem "and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall not be quenched." Jeremiah 17:27, last part. Read 2 Chronicles 36:19-21 which is an account of the fulfillment of Jeremiah 17:27. Jerusalem is not burning now. "Unquenchable" is a fire that cannot be put out. Unquenchable fire always goes out when what is burning has been destroyed.

6. What is the meaning of everlasting fire?

"Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels." Matthew 25:41. This does not say the wicked are everlasting nor that the fire will burn throughout eternity. Jude says, "Even as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire. Verse 7.

The fire that destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah is not burning today. The Dead Sea is where those cities once stood. Peter tells how the fire reduced those cities to ashes and overthrew them. Read 2 Peter 2:6.

7. What is the meaning of forever in these texts?

Read Revelation 14:10, 11; 20:10. John is talking about the torment of the worshipers of the beast in a lake of fire and brimstone. The expression "for ever and ever" in the Greek means unto ages of ages. This expression is used elsewhere in connection with God or Christ and in these cases expresses endless existence. But the meaning is derived from God and Christ with which it is associated. The expression itself does not necessarily mean an endless existence. The punishment of the wicked will be for a certain period but not an unending period which is evident from other scriptures that show the fate of the wicked to be annihilation. Read Matthew 10:28; Revelation 20:14.

Conclusion:

One thing is sure, if you choose Christ as Saviour you won't ever have to worry about being cast into hell. "Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil; learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow. Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow, though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land: but if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it." Isaiah 1:16-20.

God must destroy the impenitent because of His Holy character. Read Exodus 34:6, 7. God will execute justice for the good of the universe and for the good of those upon whom His judgments fall. God hates sin and He does all that can be done to show sinners His love. But He forces no one into obedience to His will. The choice of the wicked determines their destiny.
