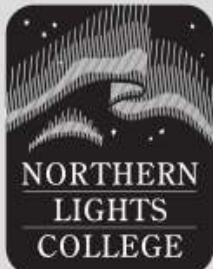



This week you should receive your 2011 property assessments from BC Assessment Authority. Initial indications are that Chetwynd's residential assessment will increase by about 19% and business by 12%. Of interest, the residential assessment increase is the second highest in BC (Mackenzie is 21%) and the business increase is also one of the higher ones in the province. Now, before you think that property taxes will increase by these amounts, I can say they won't.

Your property assessment is only one part of the equation. The amount of tax you pay is a direct reflection on how the District sets the tax rate, which is determined by our budget. The higher our budget, the higher the tax rate and the more one pays. Your individual assessment determines what portion you will pay, as compared to the rest of Chetwynd's tax payers (if your house is assessed at a higher rate than the neighbour's, you will pay more, or vice versa).

This year, Council will follow a policy that limits property tax increases to the cost of living, currently estimated to be about 2%. (Although we have not yet completed our budget process, we have tentatively agreed to most of our major budget items, thus can be fairly confident that we can keep property taxes payable to this amount.) At this time, I am not quite sure just what the rates will be for the rest of the property tax, as the Province sets the School, Municipal Finance Authority, BC Assessment Authority and Police tax rates, while the Regional District sets the Hospital, General and TV/Pool rates.

Setting the budget and the resultant tax levels is much like the "which came first, the chicken or the egg" story. What should we do first, set the tax level and then see what we can accomplish within that budget, or decide what to accomplish and then set the budget and taxes to meet that objective? In reality, it is a bit of both. We know we have many more tasks to complete than we have the budget for. We also know that we have a significant deficit when it comes to keeping our infrastructure in tip-top shape.

One frequently asked question is why we have higher tax rates, as compared to communities that have higher house values. If Chetwynd average house values are \$200,000 and we pay \$2000 in tax (hypothetical numbers) and the average house value in the lower mainland is \$1 million and they also pay \$2000, then our tax rate will be 5 times higher, although the actual amount paid is still the same. The reason is similar operating costs. If we need \$5 million to operate and another community 10 times the size needs \$50 million, the amount collected per household should be about the same, irrespective of the value of each home.

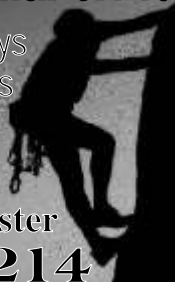

DISTRICT OF CHETWYND 2011 BC Assessment Notice

Chetwynd, BC — Early in January 2011, property owners in Chetwynd will receive their annual assessment notices from BC Assessment. Property owners are reminded that an increase in assessment values does not necessarily result in an equivalent percentage increase in municipal taxes.

The reassessment process does not generate revenue for the town. Municipalities do not benefit from property reassessment; the assessments simply distribute the share of the tax burden in an equitable fashion based on current market value. The actual change to the 2011 property tax bill will not be determined until the end of April and until other taxing authorities have completed their budget deliberations in the spring.

“Although the assessed value of residential properties in Chetwynd has increased on average by 20%, property owners will not necessarily see a 20% increase in their property taxes.” notes William Caldwell, Director of Financial Administration. “However, residents may see a modest increase to reflect a higher cost of living. Property owners with assessment increases above the average will notice a proportionately higher percent increase in municipal taxes and those with increases below the average will experience a lower than average increase.”

Once the municipal budget is determined, the tax rates will be calculated using the assessed values provided by BC Assessment. A schedule of public budget meetings and other budget related information will be posted on the District of Chetwynd website as the budget process progresses.

In January, property owners with questions regarding their new property assessments should contact BC Assessment or visit www.bcasessment.ca for more information. The website features e-valueBC – a free and easy way to compare assessments and sales online. The deadline for appealing property assessments is January 31, 2011.
