## MINISTER UNVEILS HIGHWAY 2 AND 97N FUTURE FOUR-LANING

Engineering and design work is now underway on major improvements to Highway 2 and Highway 97N in the Peace River area. These preparations are the first steps in a long-term plan to widen the corridors to four lanes on Highway 2 between the Alberta border and Dawson Creek, and Highway 97N between Dawson Creek and Fort St. John.

The Province is investing almost \$4 million this year to prepare seven initial projects for construction along these routes. The projects will improve safety and build capacity, and include the construction of passing lanes and the widening of the highway to four lanes.

**The projects under development are:**

- \* Highway 2: widen to four lanes (3.3 km) from Tupper Creek to Rusheinski Rd.
- \* Highway 2: widen Tupper Creek Bridge and 4-Mile Culvert to four lanes.
- \* Highway 2: widen to four lanes (1.8 km) from 1st St. to 8th St. in Dawson Creek.
- \* Highway 2: widen to four lanes (3 km) from Rolla Rd. to 1st St.
- \* Highway 2: Blockline southbound passing lane and intersection improvements.
- \* Highway 97: widen to four lanes (2 km) at the bottom of the South Taylor Hill.
- \* Highway 97: construct northbound passing lane at Farmington Fairways.

Engineering is underway for all projects. Projects will be tendered as design work is completed, and construction is anticipated to begin as early as 2012.

The Highway 2 and 97N corridors run 115 km from the Alberta border through to Dawson Creek and from Dawson Creek to Fort St. John. The expansion of these corridors will improve safety for residents of the region and ensure efficiency for the movement of equipment and resources in and out of the Peace, which helps drive B.C.'s economy and provide jobs for families in the Northeast.

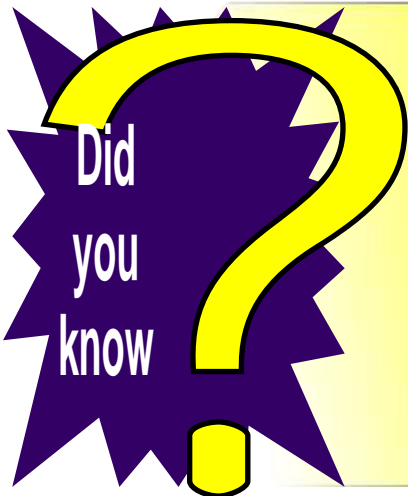

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# A Word With Your Creator

## 78. THE NEW JERUSALEM

When Jesus was about to leave this world He said there were mansions in His Father's house and He assured the disciples that He was going there to prepare a place for all the righteous before returning to take them to be with Him. Read John 14:1-3.

### 1. What kind of place did Abraham expect to inhabit?

"For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God." Hebrews 11:10.

### 2. What kind of a place is Christ preparing?

"But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city." Hebrews 11:16.

### 3. What is the name of the city?

"But Jerusalem which is above is free, which is the mother of us all." Galatians 4:26.

### 4. When John saw the New Jerusalem what was taking place?

"And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband... And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God." Revelation 21:2, 10.

### 5. What is the size of the New Jerusalem?

"And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal." Revelation 21:16.

The city is 12,000 furlongs in circumference. Using 8 furlongs to the mile this city would be 1,500 miles around, or 375 on each side.

### 6. How high are the walls?

"And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel." Revelation 21:17.

Since the walls measured 144 cubits, translated into feet- using 18 inches to the cubit- this would mean the walls are 216 feet in height. How does this agree with the latter part of Verse 16, where it says the sides and the height are "equal"? This is simply saying that the height is in proportion to the other measurements.

### 7. What basic materials are used in its construction?

The walls are jasper. The city itself is principally made of gold. The gates are of pearl. Read Revelation 21:18, 21. The foundations of the city are made of all kinds of precious stones. Read Revelation 21:19, 20.

### 8. What names are on the twelve gates?

"And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel." Revelation 21:12.

### 9. What names are on the twelve foundations?

"And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb." Revelation 21:14.

### Conclusion:

John mentions in Revelation 21:23, 25 and Revelation 22:5 there will be no night in the city. This does not mean that the sun and the moon will no longer exist, but that the splendor of the glory of the eternal God outshines the sun and moon. Read Isaiah 24:23. Isaiah 30:26 says the days and nights in the New Earth will be even more glorious. The character of those who enter that city is indicated by the character of those who are excluded. Read Revelation 21:27. Let's plan to be there.

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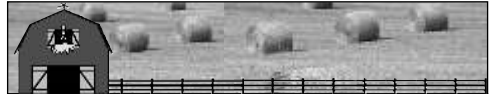

## MAYOR'S REPORT July 29, 2011

At our July 11<sup>th</sup> Council meeting we approved a "Protocol on Cooperation and Communication" (Protocol) between West Moberly First Nations (WMFN) and the District of Chetwynd. The Protocol outlines how WMFN and the District will work together in promoting a cooperative relationship between our two communities. Although having this agreement makes good sense, the purpose for this Protocol is a pre-cursor for setting the stage on how we will work together in establishing an "Urban Reserve" for WMFN within our municipality. (A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for an Urban Reserve is currently being worked on, but not yet



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complete.)

The purpose of these agreements will be to help facilitate the process in which WMFN will acquire lands within our municipality as part of their Treaty Land Entitlement (TLE) process. The TLE is part of a larger and lengthy process between WMFN and the Federal Government in which WMFN will select new lands to address lands that were not included as part of the original Treaty 8 settlement, but should have been.

The District has two options in how we participated in this. We could ignore it and let the Government of Canada establish their own "rules" as to how TLE lands are selected and managed within our municipality, or we could work together with WMFN on their TLE claim and ensure both our needs are met and that we both benefit from this arrangement.

WMFN's interests in establishing an Urban Reserve is to help contribute to the future of their government and membership by being more of a part of our regional economy and attracting new business investment to the South Peace. The District's interests are to ensure that any lands designated as "reserve land" are managed to the same level as other comparable lands within the District. Given that we cannot tax reserve lands, we also need to ensure that the District is made whole financially and able to charge "fees" to service these lands, which will approximate those who pay taxes (IE: the provision of municipal services will be charged at a higher rate than other similar land to make up for the lack of taxes).

The need exists to ensure that this relationship is fair for both parties. Neither wish to be placed in a situation or be part of an agreement where we are not treating each other fairly, or equally, and neither wishes to gain an advantage over the other, or our District landowners and tax payers. We both agree and believe that it is in our own interests that we work together, rather than leave it to the Federal government to develop their own agreements and then tell the District how we should work together.

Personally, I believe this is great for our community, as neither of our two governments are going anywhere soon, and both have a lot to offer in attracting new business to our area. It is also a process that has been used successfully in other communities across Canada. If you have any questions on this, or any other topic, please let me know. 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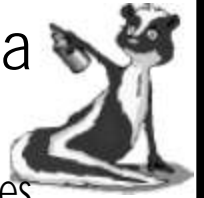
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## Robert Courtorielle-LaRocque
