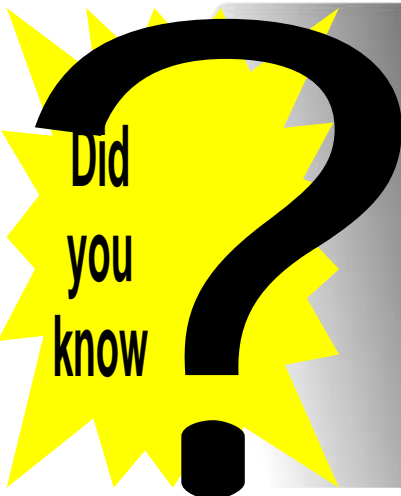

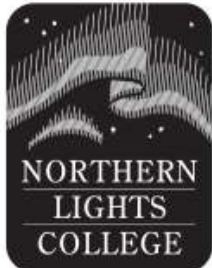

# MAYOR'S REPORT March 18, 2011

One of the last things left on my Mayor's "bucket" list, left over from when I first was elected, was the formation of a community forest. Finally, Little Prairie Community Forest (LPCF) is about to become a reality. Last month the District met with representatives from West Moberly First Nations (WMFN) and Saulteau First Nations (SFN) and we began the process to move the LPCF from a dream of our respective governments to a locally owned corporation operated by our appointed Board of Directors.

It took a long, long time to get here, but I am positive that it will be well worth the wait. We began this process sometime in 2003 when I asked SFN and WMFN if they were interested in jointly applying for a community forest. They were and in 2004 the Minister of Forests came to Chetwynd and offered us the opportunity to apply for a community forest licence. Since then, and after many sessions of questions and answers with our partners, the public and stakeholders, everyone finally got on the same page and earlier this winter, agreed to what the LPCF Corporation will be. Of note, in our original proposal, we had also included the Northern Lights College Forestry Program, but when that program was disbanded, so was their participation in the community forest.

Each of the three governments have now appointed their respective two Directors, Chetwynd's being Ben Beaulac and Tony Fazekas, and our job nears its end, as appointing Directors is the only role our respective governments will have in the operations of the LPCF. These Directors will now go about the business of finalizing the incorporation and securing the license. They will also have to raise funds to operate the business until log sales begin coming in, as all three governments have stated that LPFC will have to be financially viable on its own, as we will not provide financing. (One option is to approach the Northern Development Initiative Trust for temporary financing.) The Directors will also have to hire a Manager to run the day-to-day business of the corporation.

One positive for the new Directors is that WMFN and SFN secured some federal funding for the writing of some of the forest plans, so they won't have to start from scratch. Hopefully, the remainder of the planning will be completed this spring/summer and everything will fall into place with our community forest up and running this fall.

As to employment and contracting opportunities and the return of any profits back to the community, that will be up the Board of Directors. Our governments said that if there are to be profits, they should be used to better our residents' lives, in the form of improvements to our health, education or recreational opportunities.
