DAWSON CREEK MEDIA ADVISORY

Dawson Creek RCMP Municipal Traffic will be focussing on 'Electronic Devices' (Distracted Driving) and Novice ('N' Drivers) for the month of March 2012. Driving distractions take your attention away from driving, making you less aware of what is happening on the road around you and slowing your reaction time. Deaths and serious injuries from accidents are, for the most part, preventable. If drivers need to make or take a phone call, check email, text message, etc, while driving, they are advised to use a hands free device, or pull their vehicle over to the side of the road.

Use of an electronic device while driving, or E-mailing / texting while driving could cost you a violation ticket of \$167.00 in British Columbia.

'N' Driver's are restricted from using both hand-held and hands-free cell phones and portable electronic devices while driving. Driving is risky when you lack experience. New drivers are more prone to collisions, and one in four of these collisions result in an injury or death.

'N' Drivers failing to obey their drivers licence restrictions could receive a violation ticket for \$109.00 or higher.

For further information on using an electronic device while driving or 'N' Drivers, go to The Motor Vehicle Act of British Columbia or ICBC. For information on exceptions, go to bclaws.ca, Part 3.1-Use electronic device while driving.

RCMP want to remind drivers that the green 'N' placed on the back of a vehicle, is to ensure that other drivers are aware that the vehicle is being driven by a driver who is still learning. All drivers are encouraged to be patient, give yourself time to get to your destination and pay attention to the road and surroundings while driving.

MINISTRY OF HEALTH

Lower drug prices to benefit patients, health system

The Ministry of Health is terminating its generic drug pricing agreement with the B.C. Pharmacy Association and the Canadian Association of Chain Drug Stores, effective April 1. Health Minister Michael de Jong has asked staff to draft legislation to control and further lower the prices of generic drugs.

Patients and the public health-care system can expect to save significant amounts of money on the cost of generic prescription drugs this year, said de Jong.

Currently, generic drugs cost 40 per cent of the brand name price. That rate is already scheduled to lower to 35 per cent on April 2.

Through legislation, the Province will aim for a reduction to 25 per cent of the cost of the brand name drug by April 1, 2013.

The Province plans to have the legislation introduced during the spring sitting of the legislature.

The Province expects to reinvest savings achieved in the health-care systems to enhance patient care in a variety of ways, including keeping PharmaCare affordable for lower-income B.C. seniors and families, increasing funding for pharmacy services such as medication management and in continuing to protect rural and remote pharmacies.

In July 2010, The Ministry of Health reached an agreement with the B.C. Pharmacy Association and the Canadian Association of Chain Drug Stores to significantly lower the price of generic drugs. However, the

Province did not realize the estimated savings promised and is therefore terminating the agreement.

The Province expects to recoup those losses fully and achieve additional savings through a legislative framework.

Quick Facts: * An example of the expected savings: a typical 30-day prescription of the cholesterol-lowering drug Lipitor costs \$55, not including standard pharmacy fees. * The generic version of the drug costs 40 per cent of the brand name cost, or about \$22. * Through the draft legislation, the Province aims to lower the generic drug price to 25 per cent, or \$14.

1929 - 2012

On September 29, 1929 Delphine Mary Gayse was born to Adam BigCharles Montagnais and Sophie Chalifaux in Grouard, Alberta. She had two sisters and one brother, Irene, Marcella, and Charlie.

The family history is from Delphine herself. "We lived in East Prairie when I was very young. We moved to High Prairie when I was about seven years old so that I could start school, I was only eight years old when my dad died. I was young still, I missed him very much. I quit school at an early age so I could go to work. I did house work for a lot of people in High Prairie, then I got a job in McLennan at the hotel for \$40.00 a month. Sure sounded like big money then. I stayed there for almost a year. This was in the 1940's during the war. Then I moved back to High Prairie, went to work at the hotel there, changed jobs a few times but went back to the Spaulding Hotel. Then after the war ended in 1945, I met Wally and got married on November 19, 1948 and moved to Dawson Creek in 1949. In the early 1950's we moved back to High Prairie, stayed a couple years, and then returned to Dawson Creek. We had eleven children."

From those eleven children came 26 grandchildren and then 29 great-grandchildren, and the daughter and son in laws who held a special place in her heart.

Nana was a master of knitting slippers, dishcloths, scarves, and chair socks. Not only was Nana a mother, gardener, baker, and a cook, you could also add doctor to the list. Pinex, vicks, homemade soup, watkins rub, and cod liver oil were only some of the remedies.

Nana had a smile that would melt your heart. Anytime anyone walked in the room she always gave them her cute, innocent smile right up until her very last days.

We would like to thank the hospital staff and Arlyn for the care they gave Nana over the last couple of years. Also thank you to the many people who visited, brought cards and flowers, and attended the service. Your kindness was appreciated.

Delphine passed away on Saturday, February 25, 2012 in Chetwynd, at the age of 82 years.

A prayer service was held on Wednesday, February 29, 2012 at 7:00 pm at Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church, Chetwynd. A Funeral Mass was held on Thursday, March 1, at 11:00 am at Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church, Fr Michael Anyasoro officiated.

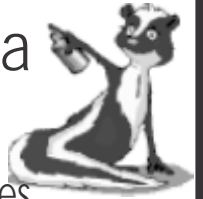

MEET THE MAYOR

March 9, 2012

Chetwynd is blessed with an enviable system of recreation trails in the green spaces along our several creeks and up Baldy linking one residential area of town with the top of the hill and the wilderness beyond. I've been up Baldy several times in the last few days and it is a wonderfully exhilarating experience. I can push the limits of endurance and feel the wind being sucked out in great gulping gasps or, more moderately, I can meander to the summit enjoying the zephyrs as I go.

While encountering hikers in ones and twos on the hill, I am acutely aware of the empty space surrounding me, in front, and behind. There's room for hundreds more hikers every week. Where are you all? Yes, I am suggesting that we Chetwynd folk (even wee Chetwynd folk) could benefit more than we do simply by using these wonderful resources that the Creator has generously spread out around us and above.

We applaud the work that has gone into modifying our own small part of creation to make it easier for us to wend our way to summits, along the creeks, and through green valleys. Our winding trails represent the vision and dedicated labour of many people. Thank you to those who went before us, laid them out, and by applying shovel, saw, axe, and muscle, have left us a recreational asset that should be in place for decades.

They will be in place for decades if we take the responsibility and foresight to treat them with respect and maintain them at least minimally. Our former Mayor loved the Baldy trail and wrote of his pleasure in climbing it frequently. I recall that he also took some personal responsibility towards its maintenance. Personal responsibility is the key. There will not likely be funds for repair and maintenance any time soon so we have to do it ourselves. We are in a user-pay situation and that is just fine. A few hours with your friends on a Sunday afternoon could result in prevention of erosion and leveling of areas that, under ice conditions, have the potential to send hikers into the bush.

One other maintenance need also caught my eye. It is called *carry in-carry out*. I am hugely irritated at the sight of debris left on the trail by witless hikers. If you are inspired to hike our trails, surely you could be inspired to carry out your junk! Yes, I do pick up other people's junk but I wonder what their houses look like. Can you imagine stepping over coke bottles, fried chicken bones, and beer cases as you manoeuvre to the table – only to slip on a splash of spilled suds and land on your back side on the greasy floor? I know it is a small minority of hikers whose self-respect and respect for our trails and other users needs ramping up. Come on, Chetwynd, let's take care of our assets. Now.

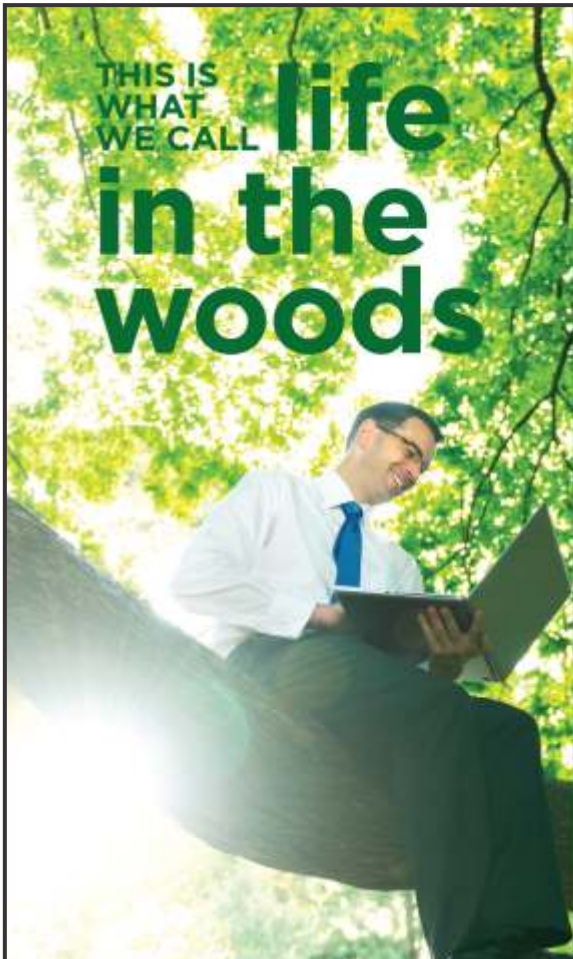
