DAWSON CREEK RCMP NEWS RELEASES

Dawson Creek RCMP Municipal Traffic are going to be focusing on 'Road Checks' for the month of October. Throughout the month, RCMP will be conducting 'Road Checks' throughout the City of Dawson Creek.

Just a reminder for drivers that do not have valid insurance while driving your vehicle, it could cost you a violation ticket of \$598. Driving with no drivers licence or an expired drivers licence could cost you a violation ticket of \$276. Drivers should check their drivers licence and insurance to make sure it is still valid.

Alcohol affects your judgement, reaction time and coordination, your ability to steer, track moving objects, brake and control your speed and lane position. Impaired driving suspensions, and vehicle impoundments and fines all start at 0.06 blood alcohol concentration. If your blood alcohol concentration is in the 'WARN' range, breath samples tested with a roadside screening device, first offence, immediate 3 day driving prohibition, \$200 fine, 3 day vehicle impoundment (tow company's rate) and \$250 drivers licence reinstatement fee. This adds to to at least \$600 for first offence.

The second offence results in an immediate driving prohibition for 7 days, \$300 fine, vehicle impoundment. This adds up to at least \$760. The third offence is an immediate 30 day driving prohibition, \$400 fine, 30 day vehicle impoundment (tow company's rate), enrolment in the Responsible Drivers Program \$880, Ignition Interlock installed for 1 year \$1730 and \$250 drivers licence reinstatement fee. Total for third offence in five year period is at least \$3960.

If your blood alcohol concentration is in the 'Fail' range, breath samples tested with a roadside screening device, you can expect to face 90 day immediate driving prohibition, \$500 fine, 30 day vehicle impoundment (tow company's rate), Responsible Driver Program \$880 and 1 year Ignition Interlock \$1730. Total for a 'FAIL' is at least \$4060. 2 and 3 year Ignition Interlock for second and subsequent offences. Even if the driver is not the registered owner, the vehicle will be impounded.

Impaired drivers may even be arrested and charged under the Criminal Code of Canada and possibly receive a criminal record. RCMP will be out in full force this month working to keep our roads and highways safe.

Over the past three weeks the Dawson Creek RCMP have responded to a 150% increase in minor thefts from insecure vehicles and are looking for the public's assistance in finding those responsible.

The thefts are occurring during the night in residential neighborhoods and are believed to be the work of a small group of youths. The vehicles that have been targeted have been left unlocked or were insecure in other ways allowing for easy access to the thieves. Items taken from the vehicles have included laptops, small amounts of cash, and personal items such as sunglasses.

Over the next week both the RCMP and Citizens or Patrol (COP) will be conducting random crime prevention checks on vehicles to alert owners to potential auto theft. If either the RCMP or COP check a vehicle, a notice will be left behind indicating that the vehicle had been checked as well as identifying any steps the owner could have taken to prevent or deter would be thieves. The RCMP are reminding people to lock their vehicles at night and are also requesting citizens to report any suspicious people checking car doors immediately to the RCMP at 250-784-3700.



If anyone has any information about the persons responsible for the thefts they can contact the RCMP Detachment or report their information anonymously to Crime Stoppers by phone at 1-800-222-TIPS, or by texting a message to 274537 and include the keyword "tipsnow".

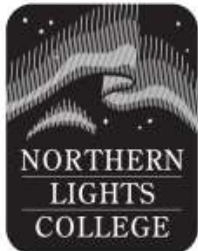

A citizen may be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a Councillor of the Saulteau First Nations if he or she meets the following criteria:

- * 18 years of age or older on the date of nomination;
- * Had not been convicted of an indictable offense within 5 years prior to the date of nomination, and consents to a Criminal Records Check;
- * Is not under any Court Order to not hold an elected office;
- * Has not been removed from a Council position based on any violations of breaches of the Saulteau First Nations Constitution within 5 years prior to the date of nomination;
- * Has not resigned from a Council position without justifiable cause within 3 years prior to the date of nomination
- * Resides or normally resides within the traditional territory of the Saulteau First Nations
- * If not currently a resident, will relocate to the Saulteau First Nations reserve #169 or its surrounding territory within (1) month from being elected.

A citizen is defined in the *SFN Election Procedures* as "any registered member of the Saulteau First Nations as per the SFN membership list." "Normally resides within the traditional territory" means someone who is temporarily away from the territory due to medical, educational or seasonal work purposes.

MAYOR'S REPORT October 7, 2011

Last week Councillors Maisey, Norris, Weaver and I attended the Union of BC Municipalities (UBCM) Annual General Meeting and Convention in Vancouver. Like the past few years, Council choose to not book any meetings with Ministers, as these sessions are very short (15 minutes), and are part of a three day marathon of meetings that the Ministers face, which at the end, they remember very little of. It is also our belief that if we need to meet, we will go to Victoria or wait until Minister's are in the north, and then meet with them on a specific topic.

This year we met with Canfor (community updates from the new CEO and his senior staff), Cardero Resource Group (planning for a new coal mine on the Burns Property in Carbon Creek, north of Chetwynd), RCMP Division "E" Senior management (dedicated housing, recruitment of experienced members, improved security clearance for Victim Services volunteers), BC Housing and BC Lands (residential housing development and multi-family construction), Urban Systems (planning for the future and Rodeo Subdivision drainage) and Geosciences BC (updates on their research into ground water in the Peace and minerals across the north). Although these meetings are interesting and can result in bettering our community, it is the resolutions debate that is the most interesting part of the convention.

Some of this year's resolutions that were of an interest to our area, included: place a moratorium on the privatization of BC's health clinic's (narrowly defeated), that a moratorium be placed on the installation of BC Hydro's "Smart Meters" (narrowly passed), place age restriction (>18) on indoor tanning (passed), redistribute part of the halibut quota from the commercial fishery to the sport fishery (defeated), three lane Highway 16 (defeated), four lane the Alaska Highway (defeated) and oppose the creation of a Municipal Auditor General by the Province (amended to say that we don't like it, but that the UBCM will work with the Province in finding ways to address local governments issues and concerns). Two resolutions that passed will result in substantial changes to the UBCM; a name change to reflect all local governments (Union of BC Local Governments) and that the UBCM pay all travel costs associated with committee meetings (which will increase the cost to the membership by 3-5%).

Listening to the resolutions is interesting and makes one think about the different ideas that people hold dear and important. For example, one resolution on control of water supply areas. Vancouver Island municipalities want the Province to provide them with the money to purchase all land within their water supply areas and assume control over any development that takes place on private lands within these watersheds. I opposed this, as it is not practical for communities like Chetwynd and Dawson Creek to either buy our watersheds, or comment on everything that happens within them. I lost and the resolution passed, but is not likely that the Province will give us the Pine River watersheds.
