Tricia Ouellette, president and founder of the society, says that once feral cats have been rehabilitated, they are then transported to partner rescues down south for adoption. Ouellette says they may have found a vehicle, but won't hear back until next week. Once the society is able to purchase their vehicle, they'll also help partner rescues with transporting their animals as well. NPFFS is also taking plant orders until April 24th to raise money to assist with the costs of the transport vehicle and overall operations.
